

CUPE 4747 SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. Student must have a parent/guardian be a member of CUPE Local 4747 for at least one full year.
2. Students must submit their application including their high school marks, letter outlining their future education plans, and a short essay about the importance of an union to its members, postmarked no later than midnight of April 30th of their graduating year. No facsimiles will be accepted.
3. Proof of acceptance at a post-secondary school must be provided before money is given. When possible, a certificate will be given at the student's graduation or awards ceremonies. The scholarship will be paid out directly to the student in January of the following year after receiving proof of attending a post- secondary school by submitting a copy of their midterm or first year post- secondary marks to the folowing email address: treasurer_4747@outlook.com
4. Scholarship may be deferred for one year, if applicant is on a waiting list or not sure if attending a post-secondary school. Letters to the scholarship committee with intent to be put on waiting list to be received by the fall.
5. Scholarship amount – minimum of \$300.00.
6. When possible, scholarship will be given at student's graduation ceremonies.
7. Selection will be made by the CUPE Local 4747 executive.
